Informational

We frequently receive public feedback from visits of 10 minutes or less that our programs have provided them with refreshingly hopeful and useful eco-information!




Educational

Research shows that to learn and remember a new concept you need to invest a minimum of **one hour** to its practice. We provide opportunities for educational growth through our Eco-Center field trips, B'Earthday Parties, workshops, panels, lectures, film festivals, and roundtables. Each are designed so that participants of all ages can understand the topic well enough to explain it in their own words, feel equipped with new eco-literacy vocabulary, and go on to inspire others!

Transformational

Ultimately it is a lasting impact that matters. Whether for **one-day** 3,000 people gather at an empowering and memorable beach clean up, or one person decides to replace plastic bags with canvas totes **every day** for the rest of his **lifetime**, it is the strength of accumulated effects that create global advances. After being exposed to our programs, we provide people with concrete ways to take action. 

Composting rangeland soils boosts photosynthesis, helping grasses pull in more CO2 and fight climate change!





